What may I expect if I join?

Caring adults from YO! Baltimore will help you set attainable, career and educational goals, as well as create a realistic *individual opportunity plan*. You will receive job readiness classes, learn how to have healthy relationships and important life skills like budgeting to support your personal goals. You'll receive physical and mental health services, GED classes and support for college. You'll gain career preparation and work experience. Training in this program will focus on industries that are hiring now such as:

- Green Collar/Environmental jobs;
- Healthcare

 Retail Sales (including the National Retail Foundation Customer Service Certification).

These services won't cost you or your caregiver anything.

How do I sign up?

What's required?

You'll be at the YO! Baltimore Center five days a week taking workshops, trainings, classes and

trips. In eight weeks, you'll make choices about where you need to invest your time—in career training or earning credits toward your diploma. You'll be able to earn, learn and become a success.
