If it is not required, should certificates of insurance be provided for each

reviewer/reviewing entity in the bid package?

Response: The Contractor is ultimately responsible for the services

provided under the Contract and for the conduct of its employees and subcontractors; thus, the Contractor shall have the minimum insurance requirements listed in Section

3.5 of the RFP.
