

Meeting Minutes  
2Gen Commission on Family Economic Security  
March 11, 2021

Secretary Padilla welcomed the group and made opening remarks.

The minutes of the January meeting were approved without changes.

Secretary Padilla introduced a working definition of the 2Gen approach for the group's consideration.

Karen Finn presented on Maryland Family Well-Being Results and Indicators.

The group divided into breakout rooms and reported on their discussions.

Group 1 discussed the working definition of 2Gen and a preliminary inventory of programs serving whole families. There were suggestions to include language such as "alignment" and "intentionally" into the definition. The group affirmed that 2Gen is not a program, but an approach; however there was discussion among the group about the value of using the 2Gen approach to evolve existing programs and services.

Group 2 continued the discussion about Results and Indicators by engaging in a "passionate selling" exercise, whereby each member argued in favor of Results and Indicators that this Commission could adopt to measure the impact of a 2Gen approach. The group selected "Babies are Born Healthy" and "Communities are Safe for Children, Youth, and Families."

A survey on results and indicators will be sent to the Commission members following the meeting and members are encouraged to share their thoughts within a week.

Secretary Padilla offered words of closing and the date of the next meeting was shared.
