 Services Administration also operates foster
 care, kinship care, and adoption programs
 to make sure every child has a place
 and home.
- Child Support Administration
 works with custodial and noncustodial
 parents and guardians to ensure children
 have the financial support they need to
 thrive.
- Emergency Assistance to Families and Children provides cash assistance to families who need help paying rent, utilities (heating, water, wastewater), or other

emergency bills.

aims to keep older adults safe and provide
them with the resources they need to thrive.

- Temporary Disability Assistance Program provides cash assistance to income-eligible Marylanders with short- or long-term disabilities, while they wait for an approval for federal support.
- Temporary Cash Assistance provides cash to families and individuals and helps them prepare for permanent employment.
- Refugee and Asylee Services helps ease the transition for federally-recognized refugees and asylees.
- Medical Assistance provides health benefits for families and income-eligible disabled individuals.
