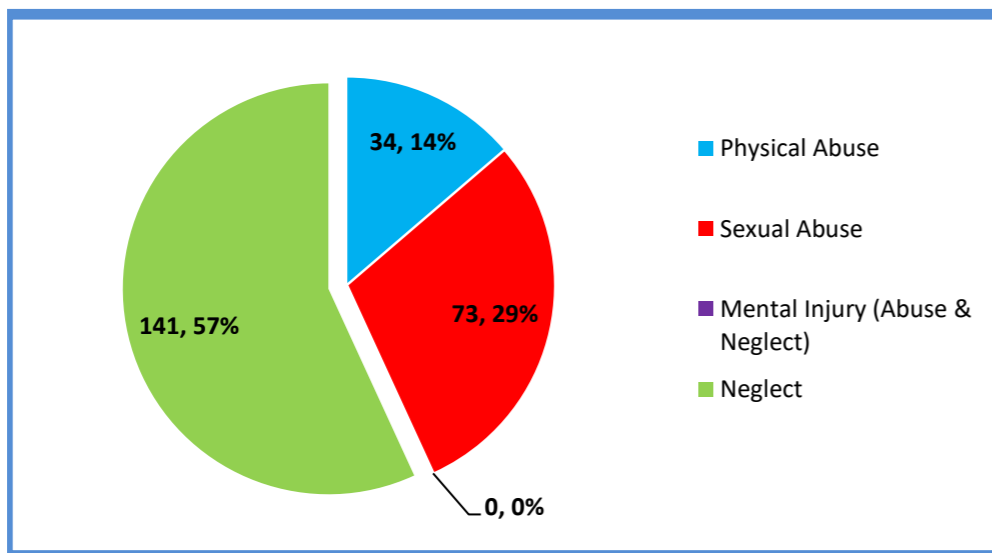

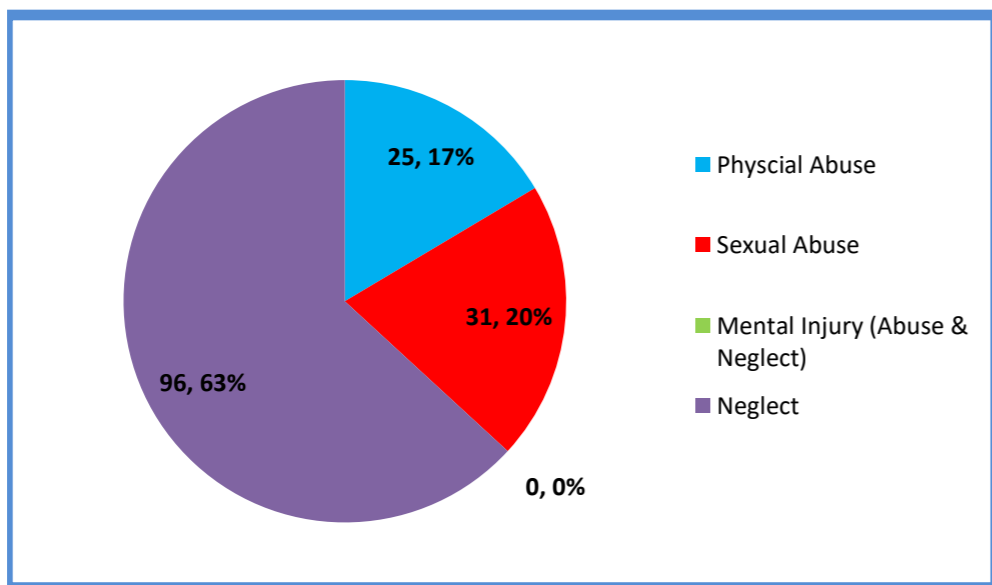

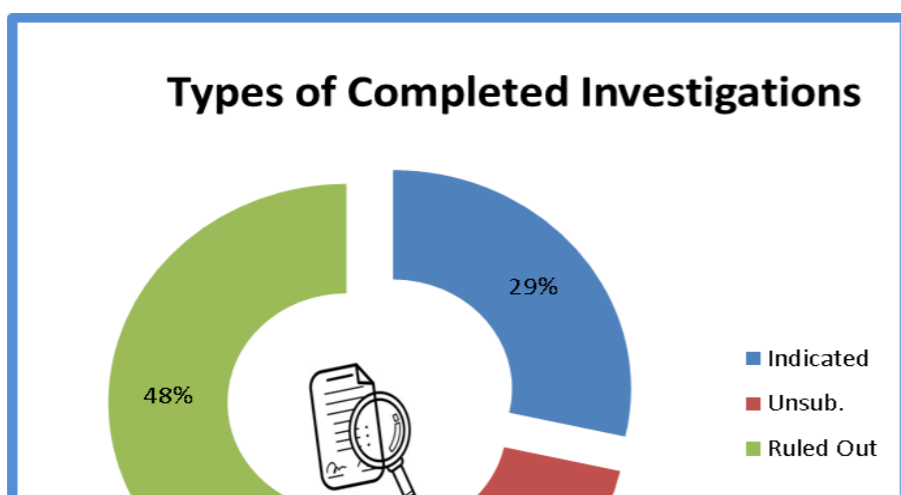

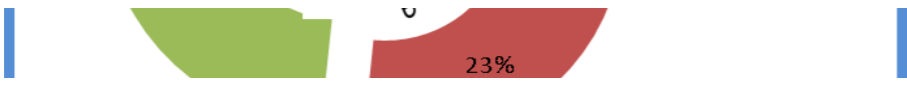

Types of Completed Investigations



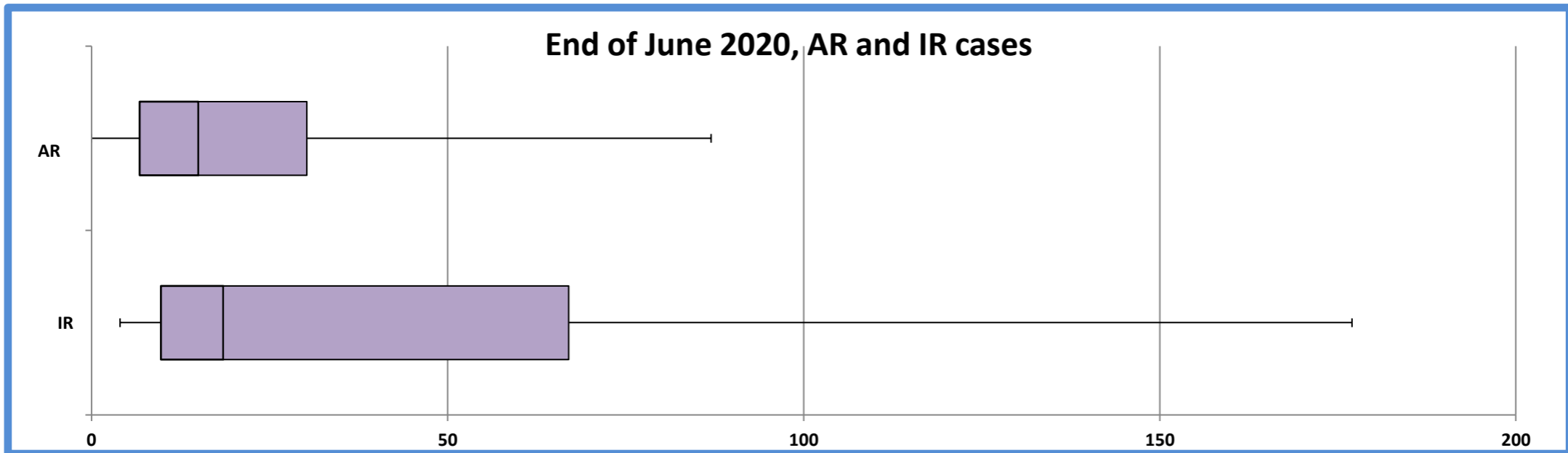

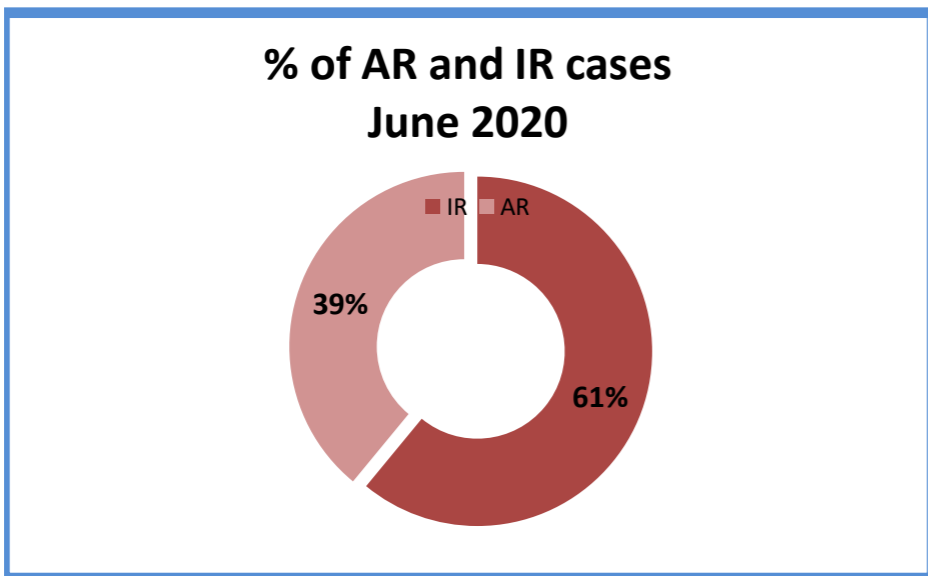

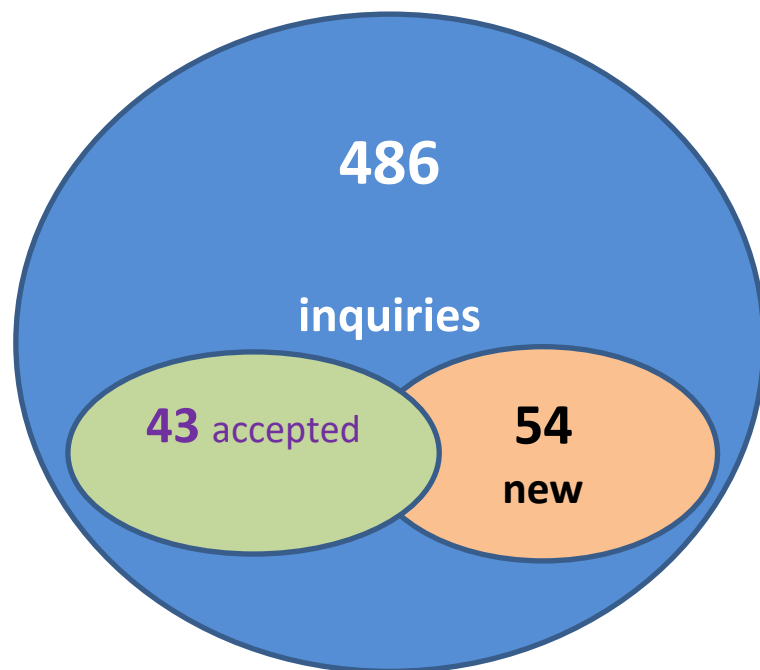
