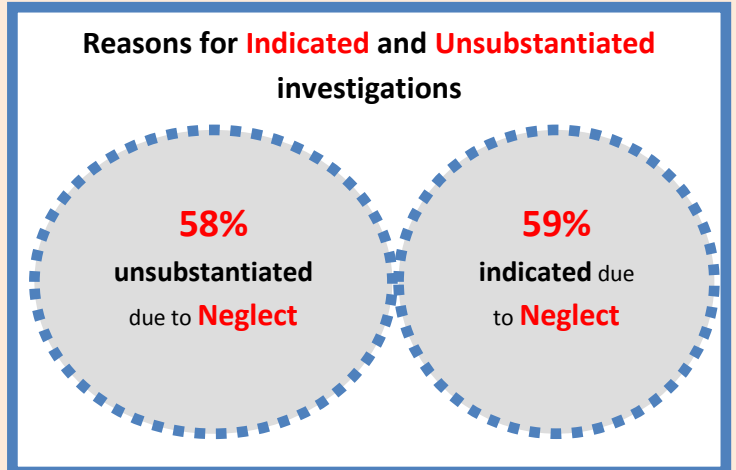

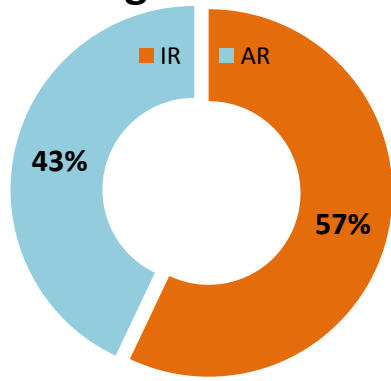

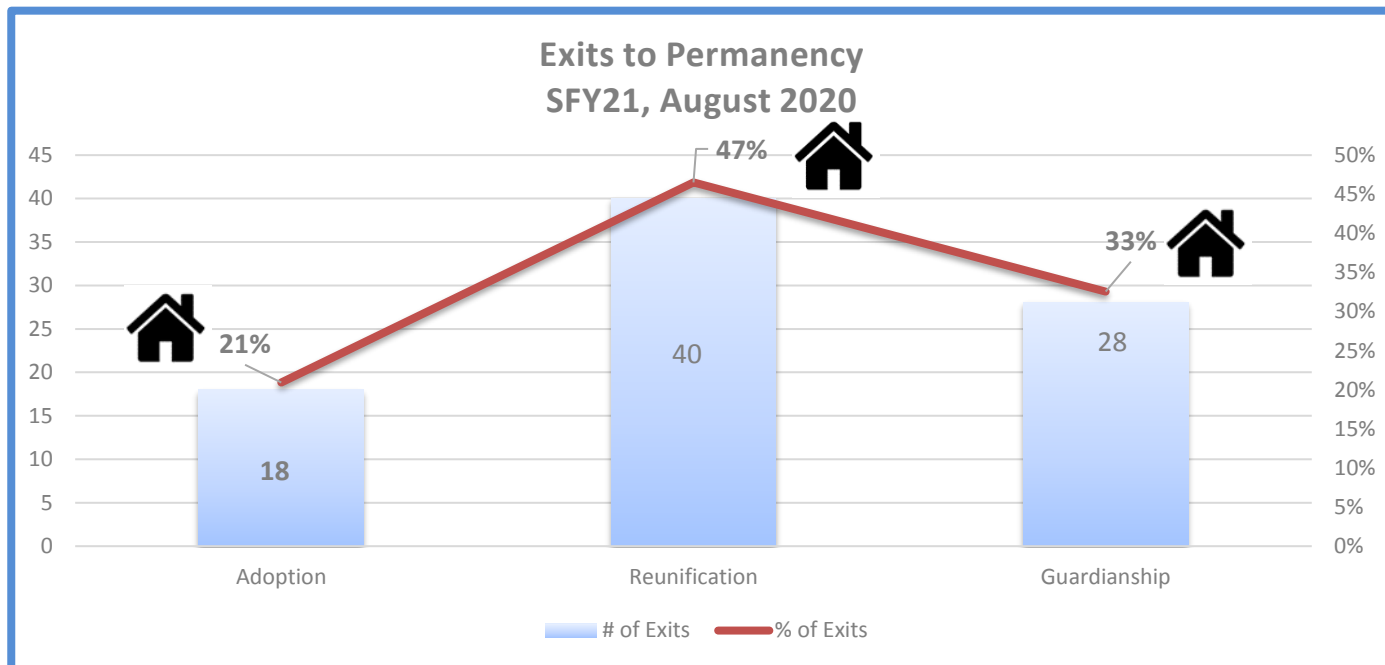

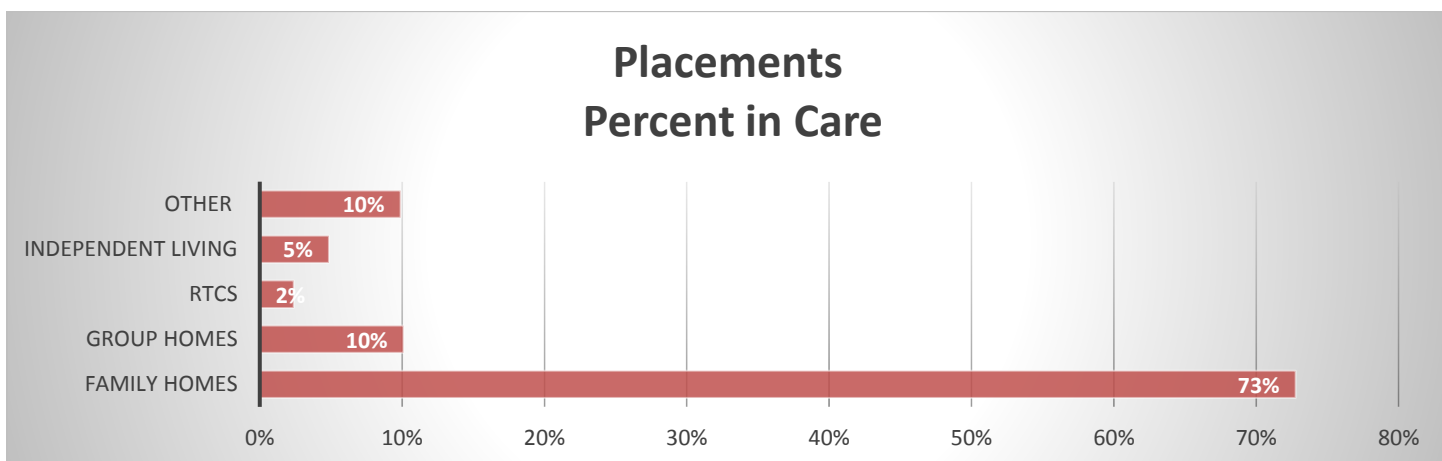
% of AR and IR cases August 2020



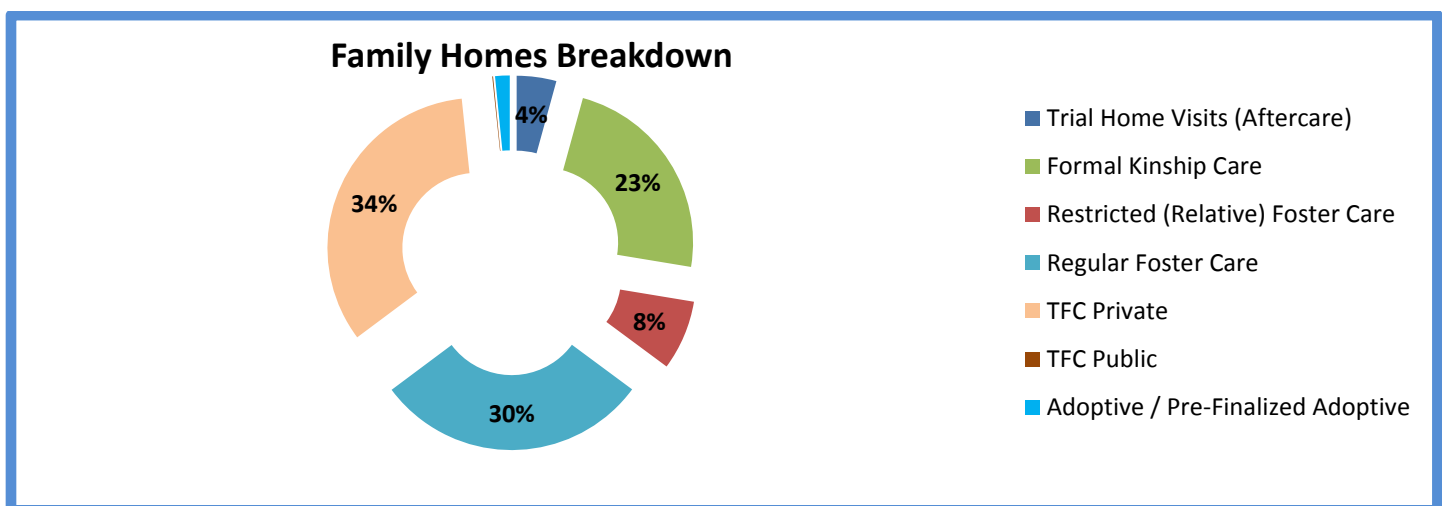

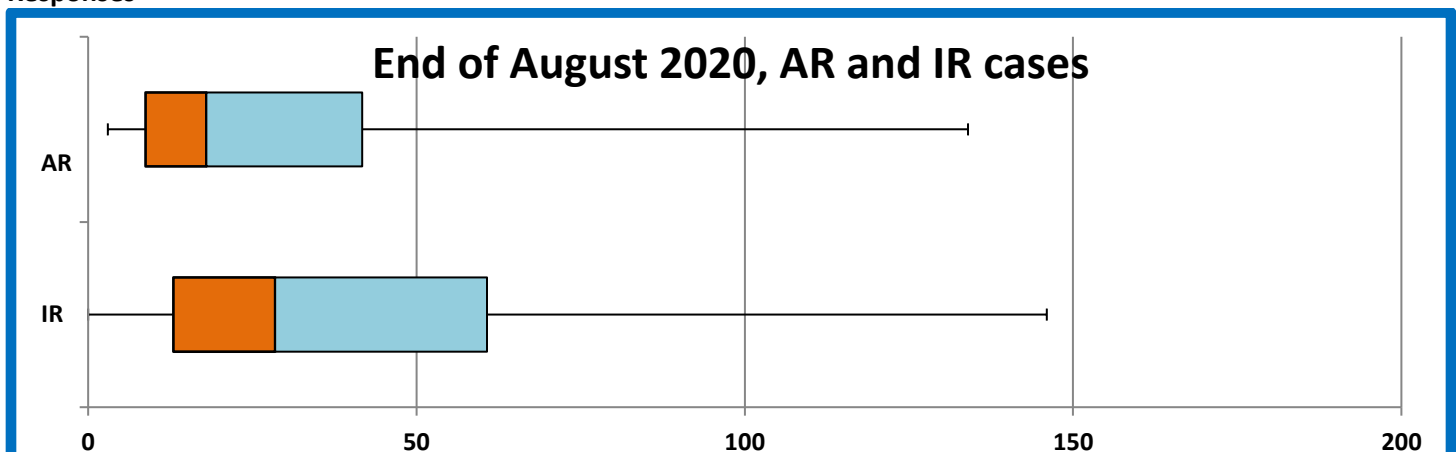

Responses



This chart displays the distribution of AR and IR cases for the end of August 2020 in Maryland. In the diagram, the middle “box” represents the middle 50% of values for the group. At the end of August, the counts of 50% of AR were about 20 and the counts of IR cases were about 30. The median value for AR was about 20 and IR was about 30. The whiskers represent values outside the middle 50%. The max number of AR and IR cases were about the same. The size of the box for AR is smaller than IR, meaning the data for AR is more similar than the data for IR.
