Vice Chair Williams commended Management Associate Wise for the outstanding services she provided on Friday evening creating and staffing an exhibit table for the MCW including the "Talk to Us" questionnaires. The next day, a public forum on education issues was convened. The remainder of the conference, which was to be a full day on Saturday, September 24 was rescheduled to December 10. Commissioners Bailey and Thomas are registered for that part of the conference. MCW Chair Bachu congratulated Vice Chair Williams on the award.

C. November MCW Meeting in Calvert County

It plans to send monthly "fact sheets" on women's health issues to the MCW's distribution lists, and will develop new sections of the resource directory addressing addictions, medicines, and other issues.

This committee is scheduled to meet October 24 via conference call at 7 p.m. It plans to conduct a thorough review of the MCW Bylaws, article by article, including a review of the MCW's enabling legislation to develop proposals that ensure congruency and to enhance the efficiency and effectiveness of the MCW operations.

The MLAW Fall Conference is this weekend, October 22.
