Take Route 32 West toward Columbia. Exit at Broken Land Parkway. (Follow signs toward Owen Brown Village Center.) Turn RIGHT onto the second Cradlerock Way - North. (Cradlerock Way is a horseshoe-shaped road.) The Library is 1/4 mile on the RIGHT.

From Rt. 29 South:

Take Exit 18 toward Owen Brown onto Broken Land Parkway. Turn LEFT onto Cradlerock Way (2nd light). The Library is 1/4 mile on the RIGHT.
