THE FIRST RESPONSE PROCESS TEACHES THREE CRITICAL COMPONENTS:

How to recognize signs and symptoms of abuse and maltreatment.


How to listen and respond to a child's needs during their initial disclosure of alleged maltreatment.

How to effectively and accurately report any form of maltreatment to authorities.
