

SCHOOL-AGED SUMMER P-EBT IS BACK!



Here's What You Need to Know . . .

- Children eligible for Summer Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) benefits must have received free or reduced-price school meals at school under the National School Lunch Program or School Breakfast Program.
- Families do not apply for these benefits. Your child was identified as eligible using school records.
- Payments to eligible children are automatically sent to a P-EBT card in your child's name.
- The total Summer P-EBT benefit amount is \$120, issued in two equal installments as follows:

SUMMER P-EBT ISSUANCE AMOUNT		
Issuance Month	School-Aged Children Amount Benefits	SNAP-Enrolled Children Under Age Six
July	\$60	Not Eligible
August	\$60	Not Eligible

Due to a change in federal law, children under six years old who are enrolled in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) are not eligible for Summer P-EBT benefits this year.

If your child has a P-EBT card, the benefits will be issued on that card. To replace a lost card, call Maryland EBT Customer Service at **1-800-997-2222**, or go to www.ConnectEBT.com.

IMPORTANT: Benefits will be expunged after 9 months of inactivity on your P-EBT card and cannot be restored.
