From the Governor of the State of Maryland

## **PRIDE MONTH**

JUNE 2025

WHEREAS,

Pride Month is celebrated each June to honor the contributions, history, and achievements of the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, and questioning community, and to recognize the ongoing efforts to achieve equality, justice, and dignity for all people; and

WHEREAS, Pride Month commemorates the Stonewall Riots of June 1969, a pivotal event in the fight for LGBTQIA+ rights, which ignited a global movement for equality, freedom, and acceptance, and continues to inspire progress toward an inclusive and just society; and

WHEREAS, The State of Maryland is committed to fostering a welcoming, diverse, and inclusive environment where all individuals, regardless of their sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression, can live free from discrimination, prejudice, and violence; and

WHEREAS, The LGBTQIA+ community has made significant contributions to Maryland's cultural, economic, and social fabric, enriching our state with their resilience, creativity, and determination in the face of adversity; and

WHEREAS,
The observance of Pride Month is an opportunity to celebrate the vibrant and diverse LGBTQIA+ community, to acknowledge the progress made toward equality, and to reflect on the work still needed to ensure full protection, respect, and opportunity for LGBTQIA+ individuals in all aspects of life; and

WHEREAS, Pride Month serves as a reminder of the importance of standing in solidarity with the LGBTQIA+ community and promoting understanding, love, and acceptance in our homes, schools, workplaces, and neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, We recognize that the fight for LGBTQIA+ rights is ongoing, and it is essential that we continue to advocate for policies that protect the dignity and rights of all Marylanders, regardless of sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WES MOORE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, do hereby proclaim JUNE 2025 as PRIDE MONTH in Maryland, and do commend this observance to all of our citizens.
