

CHANGES TO SNAP FOR INDIVIDUALS EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS



What you need to know

H.R. 1, a federal law passed by Congress and signed by President Trump, puts many Marylanders' SNAP benefits at risk.

- Individuals experiencing homelessness need to report work hours to keep their nutrition benefits.
- Some individuals may be exempt from the new work rules based on their situation. This includes those with certain health conditions and if homelessness is a barrier to work.
- Free employment and training resources are also available. Talk to your caseworker or visit our website for more information
