



# P-EBT Benefits

If your children are eligible to receive Pandemic EBT benefits, we mailed a P-EBT card in their name to your home. If you have not received a card, there are several possible reasons, such as:

- The address we have on file is incorrect
- U.S. Postal service delays

If your child has been issued P-EBT benefits but you have not received a P-EBT card, please visit the local department of social services nearest you to obtain one. Visit [dhs.maryland.gov/local-offices](https://dhs.maryland.gov/local-offices) to find an office near you.

*Note that the local office will not be able to enroll you in P-EBT. DHS uses information provided by schools to automatically enroll eligible children.*
