### 07.07.05 Establishment of Support Obligation

#### **Notice of Proposed Action**

[13-408-P]

The Secretary of Human Resources proposes to amend Regulation .03 under COMAR 07.07.05 Establishment of Support Obligation.

#### Statement of Purpose

The purpose of this action is to amend the current policy which requires the local child support agencies to pursue a modification if there is at least a 25% change in the support obligated amount after applying the child support guidelines. The proposed change requires the local agency to initiate action to modify if there is a material change in circumstance. This proposed change will make the regulation consistent with the standard set forth in Family Law Article, §12-104(a), Annotated Code of Maryland.

#### **Comparison to Federal Standards**

There is a corresponding federal standard to this proposed action, but the proposed action is not more restrictive or stringent.

#### **Estimate of Economic Impact**

The proposed action has no economic impact.

#### Economic Impact on Small Businesses

The proposed action has minimal or no economic impact on small businesses.

#### **Impact on Individuals with Disabilities**

The proposed action has no impact on individuals with disabilities.
