2. Revise Section 1.1.1, First Paragraph as follows:

Offerors shall possess a current, valid Department of Human Services/Office of Licensing and Monitoring (DHS/OLM) Residential Child Care license to provide DETP services and be in good standing with the appropriate licensing agency or have the ability to obtain licensure in the State of Maryland to provide the services for this population by January 1, 2018 March 1, 2018.

3. Revise Section 1.2.1, First Paragraph as follows:

Offerors shall possess a current, valid DHS/OLM Residential Child Care or Maryland Department of Health (MDH) Therapeutic Group Home license to provide HIGH services and be in good standing with the appropriate licensing agency or have the ability to obtain licensure in the State of Maryland to provide the services for this population by January 1, 2018 March 1, 2018.

- 5. The first set of Questions and Responses is attached.
